

Ethical Fundraising Policy

Wren Music is dedicated to encouraging people of all backgrounds to take part and experience the positive impact of making music in a group.

Our Ethical Fundraising policy ensures we do not compromise our missions and values when raising funds. This policy governs the acceptance of funds by Wren Music where, in doing so, this could be unlawful; or be contrary to our charitable objectives; or have a detrimental impact on our beneficiaries; or where we have good reason to believe a supporter is in vulnerable circumstances which means they may not be able to make an informed decision.

Potential detrimental impacts to the charity include reputational damage that may lead to a loss of support both in the short or long term. Along with implementing this policy, Wren Music has a robust decision-making process for donations and partnership opportunities that are deemed a significant risk.

To help guarantee the availability of ongoing funds to pay for our work, Wren Music aims to maintain a broad base of diverse sources of funding. The purpose of this policy is to ensure clarity and openness to all our stakeholders.

Wren Music therefore accepts financial support from, and partnership working with, organisations and individuals on the following conditions:

- It will result in a benefit to the groups of people we work with
- We are satisfied that no adverse publicity will result from accepting such support
- There is no attempt on the part of the company or individual to influence Wren Music policy or actions either explicitly or implicitly
- That initiatives do not compromise the independent status of Wren Music
- We believe that the aims of the organisation are conducive to human rights, averting climate change and promoting the positive health and wellbeing of all people
